

LOCAL RULES.

- 1. Placing of 1 club length on all fairways.
- 2. Animals hoof marks can be repaired on all greens, without penalty.
- 3. Please adhere to ALL golf course signage, throughout the course.
- 4. Please keep up with the fourball ahead of you.
- 5. Please replace all divots and repair all pitch marks on the greens.
- 6. Keep to the cart paths for as far as possible and keep carts away from Greens and Tees.
- 7. Yellow penalty areas (marked with yellow stakes) give you two relief options (Rules 17.1d(1) and (2)). Red penalty areas (marked with red stakes) give you an extra lateral relief option (Rule 17.1d(3)), in addition to the two relief options available for yellow penalty areas.
- 8. The area defined with cages around young trees, under two meters, is a no play zone that is to be treated as an abnormal course condition. Free relief must be taken from the interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.
- 9. If a player's ball lies on the course and the player's swing is impeded by the electric fence on the right-hand side of Hole 12, he or she may, without penalty, take relief under Rule 16.1, using as the reference point the point that is impeding the player's swing at the fence and an equal distance from the hole.

Out of Bounds

All boundary fences and out of bounds areas are demarcated by white stakes.

Paths

All artificially hardened paths within the boundaries of the course are to be treated as immovable objects.

Gardens & Flower Beds

Throughout the course may be treated as "Ground Under Repair"


Distance Markers (Measured to Middle of Green):
